- Independent Functional Evaluation—Individuals
 are evaluated by our multidisciplinary team, and this
 comprehensive evaluation helps determine the extent
 of the injury, the causal relationship and the expectations
 for future care and services.

THERAPY, RECREATION & COMMUNITY INTEGRATION

Large, bright rooms are designated for professional therapy services, including physical, occupational and speech language therapy and contain technologically advanced equipment recommended by our multidisciplinary team. To further enhance the NeuLife experience, we offer training kitchens, laundry rooms, a game room equipped with ping-pong, air hockey and pool tables, a large exercise room, a bistro, several Wii areas, a non-denominational chapel, surround-sound theatre, volleyball, tetherball and basketball courts, horses, nature trails and more.

Our location offers numerous opportunities for community integration, outings, recreation, job training and placement, volunteering and much more. Each client participates in the development of his or her Client Goal Plan which includes clinical goals, personal goals and activities of specific interest.

THE REFERRAL PROCESS IS EASY

Each individual referred to NeuLife will participate in an intake process where information is gathered regarding his or her history, needs and goals. Those determined to be possible candidates for NeuLife may undergo:

- Medical records review
- On-site screening evaluation at the hospital, rehab, home or any location
- Preparation of a Proposed Plan providing an all-inclusive rate specific to the specialized care and rehabilitative services identified in the plan

Basic Admission Criteria:

- Age 18 years or older
- Medically stable
- Neurologic or other catastrophic diagnosis
- Rancho IV or above (TBI)
